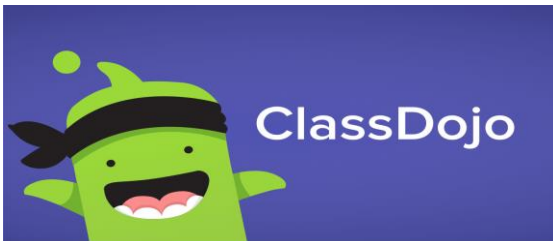
UNIFORM

TRANSITION DAYS

Year 6 are having a Reflexions workshop in school next week about moving on and should have already received separate days in July where they will be required to attend their new schools. All other classes will be having 2 transition days on Wednesday 2nd and Wednesday 9th July, where they will start and end their day in their own classes with their own class teacher, but will be spending the day getting to know their new teacher, teaching assistant and lunchtime, learning and play leader for September 2025.
