You can also contact teachers using this app, should you have any questions. Teachers will respond to class dojo messages within 2 working days. Any reports of absence, or appointments <u>must not go to teachers</u> and must be directed to the office, thank you.

### Breakfast Club

A great way to start your morning here at Bushbury is with bagels, crumpets, a choice of cereals, fruit and juice and a chance to chat, play and exercise with your friends! We are kindly sponsored by Warburtons who provide us with crumpets and bagels as a community goodwill gesture. Our FREE Breakfast Club is for Reception to Year 6 children. Sadly, Nursery children cannot attend due to rules on ratios. Admission into the breakfast club is from 8:00am until 8:20am each morning. Remember parents and carers can drop off using the kitchen entrance or come in via the main office. Please do not leave your children unaccompanied before 8am.







Each child is allocated a Class Dojo 'house' and is given a PE kit in colour to match. Each year, the houses change according to the Summer 2 topic across the school, which in 2026 will be 'ECO', where we will be increasing diversity and building bug hotels! The children collect Dojo reward points for themselves and their house. The winning house each week is celebrated in assembly and the points are updated on the website to see who gets the most over the term. We are also learning about Alice in Wonderland and are looking forward to a theatre performance!

#### HOW DO WE LET YOU KNOW HOW YOUR CHILD IS DOING?

We have an open evening in the Autumn and the Summer term, where you can see the children's books and talk to the teachers about their progress and targets. In the hall, you can also chat to our learning mentors, office and catering staff. In the Spring term, we offer timed appointments with your child's class teacher. We send you home three reports a year, which show you where your child is at and what we can all do to help them fulfil our motto and 'be the best that they can be'. In the meantime, we invite you in to learn together and communicate with you on class dojo by sharing your child's successes.


## RECEPTION PARENT /CARER - TEA and TOUR - FRIDAY 19<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER AT 9AM
