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Bushbury Hill Primary School Breakfast Club Policy

Introduction

Bushbury Hill Primary aims to provide a welcoming, safe and secure environment for pupils before the beginning of the school day whilst providing children with a nutritious breakfast in a pleasant and relaxed environment.

BHPS Breakfast club is part of the National Breakfast Programme funded by the Department for Education and run by Family Action. Their support provides our children with a healthy choice of cereal at the start of each day. Alongside this, we have been able to join the Warburtons foundation who are very kindly donating fresh bagels and crumpets weekly.

None of our children at Bushbury will be hungry and we do provide a tray of bagels at the school office each day, for children who are too late for breakfast club and for whose parents have not been able to provide breakfast for them.

Registers

A register of all children in Breakfast Club will be taken as children enter the building, either through the main reception or through the hall entrance.

Opening Times

Breakfast club commences at 8am and closes at 8.20am.

Payment

From September, 2022 breakfast club is free and there has been no charge to Parents/Carers.

Activities

Once the children have eaten their breakfast, children are able to play games with their friends with a wide range of activities including board games, colouring, etc. For the last 10 minutes of the session, the children are able to participate in yoga/stretch, just dance or whole club games before going to class.

In addition to this, we run a Nurture Breakfast Club. This club provides a quieter environment in the Rainbow Room, with a sensory emphasis that may benefit vulnerable children or children with SEND.

Behaviour

School Behaviour Policy applies to all children. If children constantly breach the School Behaviour Policy at Breakfast Club, then they may be prevented from attending Breakfast Club for a period of time.

Pupils' belongings

To ensure the safety of both staff and pupils, all children's belongings (e.g. bags and coats) are placed within large sacks clearly labelled with the children's class. Any belongings on the floor will be picked up immediately and placed within the secure bags. Each class will be instructed to collect their belongings one class at a time at the end of the session.

First Aid

- Accidents will be dealt with by a qualified 1st Aider
- All accidents will be recorded in the school accident book
- Should a child become unwell during breakfast club, parents will be contacted immediately.

This policy will be renewed every 2 years or sooner if needed.
