



Our Topic this half term is:

How does the world get angry?

We covered some of this in remote learning but there are still some areas which we didn't complete.

We will be:

- Finding out about eight of the main Natural Disasters.
- Looking at where in the world do these disasters happen.
- Looking at the devastation caused by a natural disaster.
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- Looking at the differences between hurricanes and tornadoes.
- Creating a news report in computing, featuring a natural disaster.
- We will be also looking at how we can get energy from natural sources – ECO School link.



How can you help your child at home?

- ✓ Helping them to research information based on natural disasters will be given a specific one to research.
- ✓ Hearing them read each night.
- ✓ Asking them about what they have been doing and what they have learnt.
- ✓ Encouraging them to learn their spellings and multiplications, ready for their weekly test.
- ✓ Ensure that they are in school on time so that they don't waste valuable learning time.





In Literacy we will be:

- Reading a range of genres, linked to our writing.
- Writing a news report about a natural disaster.
- Writing an explanation about how tsunamis occur.
- Producing a charity appeal leaflet to help victims of a hurricane.

In Science we will be learning about Living things and their habitats.

- To know how to place an organism into one of the five kingdoms.
- To learn about bacteria and micro-organisms.
- To classify vertebrates and invertebrates based upon their characteristics.

Treats for our topic:

We haven't got any trips planned based on this topic, however we will be watching lots of appropriate video clips showing natural disasters in action.
