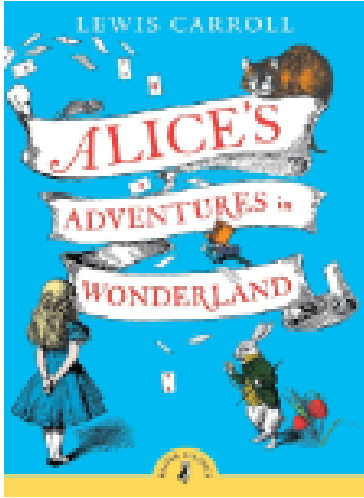

TRANSITION DAYS

We teach the children all about moving on in many different ways; through assemblies, stories and meet the teacher days. Year 6 are having a Reflexions workshop in school about moving on and should have already received separate days in July where they will be required to attend their new schools. All other classes will be having 2 transition days on Wednesday 1st and Wednesday 8th July, where they will start and end their day in their own classes with their own class teacher, but will be spending the day getting to know their new teacher, teaching assistant and lunchtime, learning and play leader for September 2026.

OPEN EVENING

Books will be sent home the week beginning Mon 13th July for you to look at. We ask that you send in a strong carrier bag or bag for life for that week.
